 Production and distribution of quality seeds are insufficient compared to the demand of the public as was announced during the launching of Seed Guidelines in June 2015

MEETING FARMER'S SPECIFICATIONS

• Farmers lodging complaints at the Fiji Crop and Livestock Council that they do not have access to the range of seeds that they feel would improve the quality of Fiji's produce and increase their income.

<u>CONSTRAINTS</u>

- 1. There are number of hybrid seeds available overseas but due to quarantine requirements, we cannot take advantage of this excellent opportunity to grow and diversify our crops.
- 2. Approval to import a new seed type takes up to three years.
- 3. Cyclone season affects seed production and sales.
- 4. Finding hybrid seeds that are suitable and that which thrives well in our climatic region.

POSSIBLE SOLUTIONS

- Review the approval process if there is any possibility of attaining results in a shorter time frame
- Performing research, working together with relevant authorities seed exporters and business partners to better understand specifications as well as requirements.
